

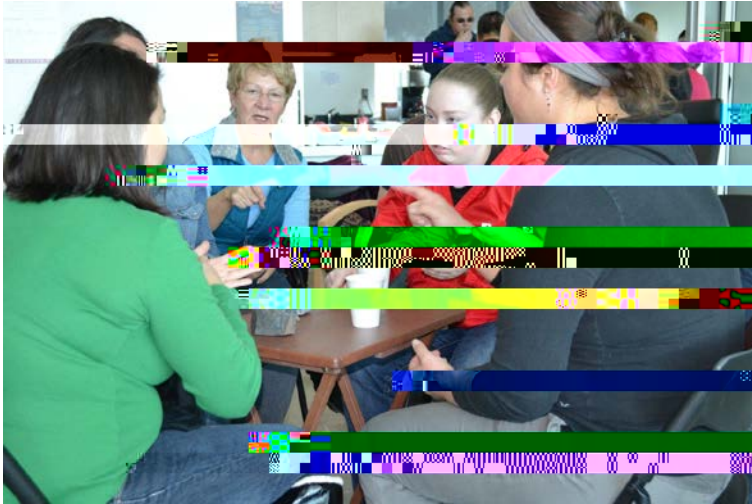

Alutiiq Language OEC



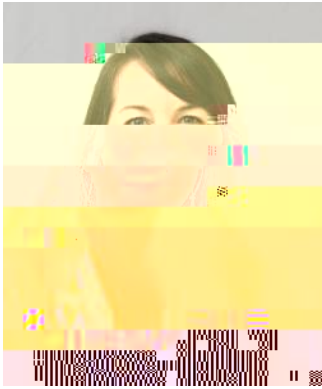
- 6 courses developed
