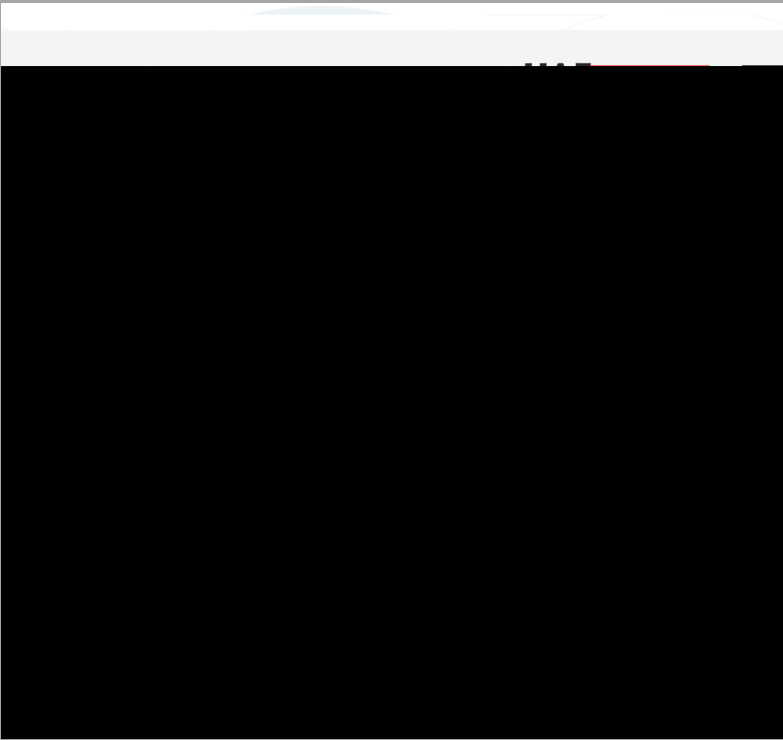

 2011 - Present: Alaska Statehood



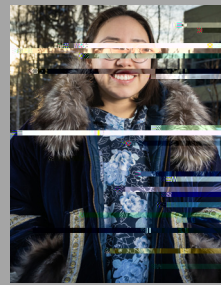

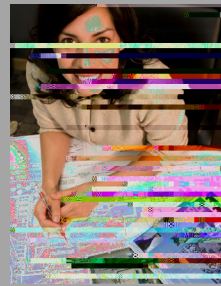
