Student credit hour registration is projected to increase about 4 percent (6,700 SCH) over last year, reaching nearly 170,500 SCH by the end of term. More than 2,750 additional students are anticipated to enroll by the close of Spring 2025, for a total headcount of about 21,060 students, a decrease of approximately 2 percent (440 students) from Spring 2024.

At this point, about nine out of ten students who will likely enroll by the end of Spring 2025 have registered, accounting for more than 95 percent of Spring 2025 student credit hours (SCH). Refer to pages 5 and 6 for graphs displaying historical and current course registration patterns for headcount and SCH, respectively.

As of February 10, 2025, 18,305 students had registered for 16 3,145 Spring semester credit hours, system wide. This represents a 3 percent decrease in 4 percent increase in student credit hour registration (6,060 SCH) from the levels observed this time last year. UAA student headcount decreased about 7 percent (777 students) and student credit hours grew just over 2 percent (1,853 SCH) compared to last year. UAF student headcount was nearly 3 percent higher (196 students) and student credit hour registration was 6 percent higher (3,368 SCH) year-over-year. UAS headcount was almost 3 percent higher (51 students) and student credit hour registration increased about 7 percent (839 SCH) compared to this time last year.

More than four percent of registered students (7 59 individuals) are taking classes concurrently at multiple universities within the system this semester. See page 2 for additional detail about underlying student headcount and student credit hour changes by academic unit and campus.

New applications and admissions for degree seeking program majors are largely complete for the Spring 2025 semester. More than 3,2 80 students were accepted for admission in Spring 2025, up approximately 9 percent (260 individuals) from this time last year. About 57 percent of applicants admitted to undergraduate programs and 81 percent of those admitted to graduate level programs have elected to enroll.
