RE: Discontinuation of the Undergraduate Certificate in Geographic Information Systems

Attached is the Program Action Request (PAR) form seeking Board of Regents action to discontinue the Undergraduate Certificate in Geographic Information Systems.

Admissions to the certificate were suspended in August 2015 with planned deletion as a result of Program Prioritization, due to persistent low enrollment and low student interest.

Consistent with UAA's suspension guidelines, a teach out of all students in the program has been completed and no students remain in the program. The discontinuation has gone through the regular curricular process and has been approved through the Faculty Senate, the Provost, and the Chancellor. There are no resources or faculty tied to the program. There are no other impacts on programs or stakeholders.
