
Ten years from now


Assuming that the demand for marine policy specialists keeps pace with the average rate of increase in federal regulation, we estimate that the annual demand ten years hence will be 24-37 positions in Alaska.

How have positions been filled to date?


Agencies and organizations have hired from a national pool of policy analysts. They have hired graduates of the recently discontinued UAF MS Resource Economics program, the UAF MS and PhD Fisheries programs, and the UAF MS Natural Resources and Environment program. Agency leadership indicates a preference for hiring individuals who have worked or studied in Alaska. However, they have more positions than they can fill with Alaska-trained analysts.
